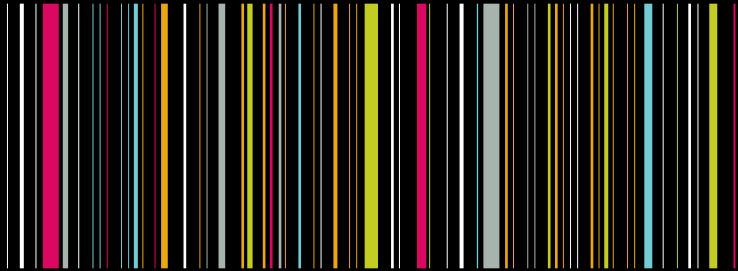

## A SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITY STRATEGY FOR WARRINGTON VISION, AMBITIONS AND PRIORITIES

### VISION

By 2030, Warrington will be recognised as one of the best places to live and work in the UK, where everyone enjoys an outstanding quality of life.

In pursuing our ambitions we will prioritise **closing the gaps** in quality of life for our most disadvantaged communities.

#### Ambition

### PROSPEROUS AND VIBRANT:

where people benefit from being part of a successful and dynamic economy with vibrant town and district centres.

#### Priorities:

1. Safeguard and enhance Warrington's position as a key UK economic centre
2. Encourage local enterprise
3. Maintain the Town Centre as a successful retail destination and increase the variety and mix of uses to enhance the leisure and cultural offering
4. Increase the employment rate of key groups.

#### Ambition

### ENVIRONMENTALLY RESPONSIBLE AND ATTRACTIVE:

where people have good housing, accessible transport and enjoy caring for their environment.

#### Priorities:

1. Improve waste management and increase recycling
2. Improve the look of the borough
3. Reduce reliance on the car and minimise delays for travellers
4. Reduce CO<sub>2</sub> emissions and prepare for climate change
5. Meet all our housing needs and ensure an adequate supply of affordable homes.

#### Ambition

### SAFE AND STRONG:

where people are active and supportive in their communities, feel safe and live free from crime and anti-social behaviour.

#### Priorities:

1. Increase community involvement and responsibility
2. Guard against future threats to community cohesion
3. Enable a thriving voluntary and community sector
4. Reduce anti-social behaviour
5. Reduce violent and acquisitive crime.

#### Ambition

### HEALTHY AND ACTIVE:

where people can enjoy good health and wellbeing.

#### Priorities:

1. Reduce premature mortality rates to below the England average
2. Reduce health inequalities across Warrington
3. Support elderly and vulnerable people to live independently.

### AMBITIOUS AND ACHIEVING:

where people are inspired and supported to reach their potential and lead fulfilling lives.

#### Priorities:

1. Increase the educational attainment for children from areas of deprivation and looked after children
2. Increase skills
3. Boost aspirations and opportunities for all ages.
